INTRODUCTION

Lake Skadar-Shkodra is the largest lake in the Balkan Peninsula shared between Montenegro and Albania. The Montenegrin part of the lake and its surrounding area were declared a national park in 1983 and in Albania a Managed Nature Reserve. In 1996 in Montenegro and in 2006 in Albania, Skadar-Shkodra Lake was included in the Ramsar list of wetlands of international importance.

Lake Skadar is a wonderful place with mirrored waters, rocky shores and wetlands full of wildlife with more than 270 species of birds, plenty of natural herbs, traditional fishing villages, numerous islet monasteries and cultural heritage sites, fascinating beaches surrounded by karst mountains, various amusing, social and cultural events.

Lake Skadar area is where some of the best wines and organic food in Montenegro can be found, cultivated by the local producers especially in Crmnica and Godinje valleys in Montenegro and Shtoj village in Albania.

There are also numerous accomodation facilities, restaurants and shopping centers, on the Montenegrin and Labanian sides of the lake that make this area attractive to hiome and foreign tourists.

Being a tourist attraction with all these natural and cultural resources the aim of this inventory is to prepare a joint Montenegrin and Albanian inventory on tourist facilities and capacities of Lake Shkodra area, to promote Lake Skadar-Shkodra as a joint tourist attraction internally and internationally.

The inventory is focused on main travel destinations and available information related to tourist services around the lake in Montenegro and Albania. This inventory includes places and tourist destinations related to nature and landscape, beaches, places for boating, swimming, cycling, hiking, bird watching, hunting, and recreational fishing around Lake Skadar-Shkodra etc.

Very carefully have been listed in this inventory the historical sites and buildings including monuments, archaeological sites, museums etc.

Traduitional events with artistic and ethnographic value and community basd traditional celebrations on esch side of the lake and joint events are well listed in this inventory.

This inventory provides also useful information and useful tips related to travel and tourist services and facilities associated with information related to: distances; emergency numbers including hospitals, police stations; hotels, tourists agencies restaurants and traditional food of the area; visitors' centres, travel by bus, train, aeroplane, taxi; banks, car rentals, etc.

1. Skadar Lake National Park

The Montenegrin part of the lake and its surrounding area were declared a national park in 1983. In 1996, by Ramsar Convention on Wetlands, it was included in the Ramsar list of wetlands of international importance.

Natural attractions in SLNP include magnificent landscapes, islets, coves, fjords, rare birds, fish, underwater spring and water lilies. The lake surface is covered with aquatic plants, dominated by yellow and white water lilies. Bird-watchers will have the chance to enjoy a habitat for 270 bird species, including rare pelicans, herons, cormorants, ducks, snipes, partridges, storks and many other species. The lake is the habitat of more than 51 kinds of fish, the most important of which are carp and bleak as autochthonous species and sea-bass, skipjack etc as migratory species.

Cultural Skadar Lake region which has been witness to Montenegrin history since the early Middle Ages offers more than 20 monastery complexes, churches, settlements and other cultural and historical monuments dating from different periods of time.

Visitors enter the Skadar Lake Nationl Park at two points: Virpazar and Vranjina.

II. TOURIST ACTIVITIES

Cruising


Virpazar is the town from which most of the ships take of F all over Skadar Lake, especially cruise ships. Boat cruises are organized by licensed entrepreneurs. Boats depart from docks in Vranjina, Virpazar and Plavnica. The most popular tour is a visit to Krajina region with Starcevo, Beska and Moracnik islands, and the region of Rijeka Crnojevica.

Birdwatching

Skadar Lake is a habitat for 281 bird species, which presents about 50% of the total number of European bird species. Among the bird species is a Dalmatian pelican, particularly rare in Europe, which is the symbol of the National Park. Birdwatching at the lake may be carried out from small boats or from specially constructed bird watching towers and platforms. The best period for birdwatching is during winter or autumn, when the Skadar Lake area is visited by numerous flocks of migratory birds.

V. CULTURAL HISTORICAL ATTRACTIONS IN SKADAR LAKE AREA.

A great richness of cultural heritage, including numerous archaeological findings, fortifications, monasteries, churches, traditional rural architecture, and many other valuable complexes, as well as significant spiritual culture, indicate that this region is an important part of the Montenegrin history and culture from 11th century up to now. The cultural and historical importance of the islands in the Skadar-Shkodra lake is enormous because on these islands numerous monasteries, churches and holy monuments are situated.

Manastir Precista Krajinska



The Remains of the Monastery with the church are located in the village of Ostros in Krajina. It is dedicated to Assumption of the Holy mother of God and represents one of the significant monuments and oldest monastery in the area.

Monastery Of Vranjina

The monastery, on an island in Lake Skadar, was founded in 1233. For a long time had a significant cultural and political role of the state in Zeta. On a strategic location, the monastery suffered from Turkish attacks, causing collapse in 1557 and 1714 and finally destroyed in 1862. In the 1886th Prince Nikola restored monastery. The church is well preserved. Collegiate Church of St. Nicholas in size and decor is different from other churches of the era of large renovation of temples in the Montenegrin Prince Nicholas I



Monastery Beska



The monastery is situated on the island Beska, on Skadar Lake. Monastery consists of two churches: a bigger church – dedicated to Saint George from the XIV century, and a smaller one – dedicated to St. Holy mother of God from 1440. It was famous for its intensive transcription activities. The Gorička Anthology was written in this monastery

Starcevo Monastery

It is located on the island of Starčevo on Skadar Lake. It was founded in 1377 and consists of the Church of the Assumption of the Mother of God, an accommodation building, supporting structures and a surrounding wall with a gate and several underpinned terraces. The monastery was a centre of literacy, printer Božidar Vuković from Podgorica was located in this monastery where many manuscripts were rewritten and many books were bound and decorated



Moracnik Monastery



Kom Monastery

It is a Serbian Orthodox monastery in Montenegro located on the small island of Odrinska gora. The Kom Monastery was built between 1415 and 1427, during the rule of the Crnojevići. During its existence, the monastery was an endowment of Đurađ and Lješ It is situated on Skadar Lake's Island of the same name. The monastery complex raised by Balsa III between the years 1404 and 1417 consists of a church dedicated to the Holy Mother of God, an accommodation building, dining room and high tower with four floors, surrounded by a stone wall with a monumental gate.

Crnojević. The oldest frescas in the monastery are from the second half of the 15th century. For a short period of time, the monastery was the center of the Zetan Metropolitanate.



Rijeka Crnojevica

It was the old capital in the time of Crnojevic dinasty and an important trade town during the middle ages. Due to its historical significance and its dominating position it is one of the most interesting tourist attractions around Lake Skadar. The most important monuments are Ivan's palace and the church of St. George, the architecture shows the and Venetian influence from the early period of the town's existence, as well as the Turkish influence from the

Besac Fortress



period of their occupation. Main activities here are: The Old Bridge is the main object of the village. It was built by King (Knjaz) Danilo in 1853



The Besac Fortress, is situated on the hill. right above Virpazar the community. The fortress Besac represents a fortification complex that originates from the Turkish times, the second half of the 15th century, and it is also assumed to have a younger fortification with towers inside the walls – from the period of medieval Zeta, it represented a border between the Montenegrin and the Turkish territories of the time, and thus, it has historic value

Grmozur (a.k.a. Montenegrin alcatraz)

The fortress on the isle Grmozur was built by Turks in 1843. King Nikola I and his army conquered this island in 1876 and decided to build a prison on it. It was the first organized prison in the region which had its regulations. By these regulations, guards and other personnel had to be non-swimmers. Clause 11 says that in case that a prisoner manages to run away, the guard in charged for him would have to be imprisoned instead of a prisoner.

Lesendro Fortress





The Lesendro fortress is an important exceptionally cultural historical monument but its exact build date. The fortress Lesendor was reconstructed in 1832 by bishop Rade. For the eleven years that the fortress of Lesendro it is said that most of his greatest works where written here. In 1843, Oman pasa conquered Lesendro and Vraniinu since which time it has become abandoned.



VII. CULTURAL HERITAGE ATTRACTIONS IN BAR

Trikhonos Of Bar

According to some historical sources dates from the VI century. It is located in the very center of Bar in the community Topolica.

• St. Tekla`s church

That building was constructed in the XIII century and is located in the place called Sutomore, the suburb of Bar. Primarily St. Tekla's church was an orthodox religious object, so that after some time it got another catholic object. St. Tekla's church has two altars even today, and citizens of both orthodox and catholic religion visit it.

Monastery (Convent) Or Mother Of God Of Ratac

It was constructed in the IX century, is situated in the cape Ratac, between Bar and Sutomore. The convent used to be composed out of 3 churches as well as several buildings, which had towers and defense walls.

Monastery Upper Brceli

It is located in the village called Brceli, in Crmnica and it was built at the beginning of the XVIII century. In the complex of the monastery there is a church dedicated to the Shroud of the Holy mother of God as well as the iconostasis dated from 1928.

Monastery Lower Brceli

It is located in Crmnica, about 10 kilometers away from Bar, in the village lower Brceli. Monastery was built in the XV century, and in its complex there is a church dedicated to St. Nikola.

Omerbasic`S Mosque

It is located in the Old Bar, and was built in 1662 with a simple construction.

The Fortress Haj – Nehaj

It is located in the Spic area, and was built in the era of the Venetian Republic on a small hill, high above the seashore in the XV century.

ALBANIA

I. PLACES TO VISIT

Shkodra city is one of the biggest cities of Albania. Shkodra, having a history of more than 2000-year, natural landscapes and a rich history of traditions and events, has always attracted the foreign visitor. In Shkodra, there can be found many constructions, artisan work, literary works, works of art, from Illyrian time (III century B.C.) to the years of new era. Shkodër was founded around the 4th century BC.



Zogaj village is one of the most beautiful beaches in Lake Shkodra. The village with a healthy climate is well known for family tourism and fishing.

Bujana/Buna River



Shiroka village lies by the side of Shkodra Lake at the foot of Taraboshi mountain. It is 7 km from the city and has excellent climatic conditions. The food served at the restaurants is delicious. Bathing, fishing, sail and climbing the mountain are some of the main activities in Shiroka



Its source is in Shkodra Lake and after 1.5 km Buna/Bujana joins the Drini and its flow into the Adriatic. The Bojana / Buna is navigable throughout its whole course.

Drin River

The Drin river with a strong water flow is the longest in Albania and only 17.7 km flow through Shkodra territory. Very close to Shkodra, the Drin River joins the Buna River and in the vicinity of Albania-Montenegrin border, both of them flow into the Adriatic Sea.

Kiri River

It rises in the Alps and bears alpine characteristics. In Shkodra it joints Drini and togetyher with Buna they flow into the Adriatic Sea.

The Buna Delta

The delta is created at the mouth of the flow into the sea and it is populated by a rich variety of animals, including spoonbills, pygmy cormorants, ston curlews etc.

II. ACTIVITIES IN LAKE SHKODRA

Hiking

Most preferable hiking train in Lake Shkodra area is: Tarabosh mountain-Zogaj-Shiroke, a low mountainous climbing type with marvelous lake view in background. Best time for hiking is April until October end.

Road length is 22 km from which: 10km $\,$ - mountainous walking $\,$ and 12km $\,$ - plain field $\,$

Biking

Biking around Lake Shkodra is a wonderful experience. A total 44 km from Zogaj Village up to the border crossing in Hani Hotit is blessed with nice landscape. Hotel Tradita provides biking tours.

Fishing

Sports fishing in Lake Shkodra can be exercised in may points along the shore but most preferred are the old and new Buna Bridge.

IV. CULTURAL HERITAGE AND ATTRACTIONS

Rozafa Castle

The citadel one of the most important monuments in Albania situated 135 m high above the sea level. The Illyrians' walls, consisting of huge rocks date back to 350BC. The main medieval building still standing is St. Stephen's Church, built in 1319 and expanded by the Venetians in the 15th century. The history of Rozafa is the history of the city itself and it is. From the walls you have great views across the city, Lake Shkodra with the mountains of Montenegro behind it, the Buna river flowing towards the sea, and the Kiri and Drini rivers which join just below

the castle before flowing into the Buna.Rozafa Castle is just 3km south of the city centre



The English Tower



It is a small stone clock tower built in 1868 by an English lord. Originally it was built as a gothic church. It is composed of a two storied building and a tower. It can be viewed from outside, as the inner part is no more available for visitors.

Markagjoni Tower

It is decorated with neo-Renaissance and topped with a zigzag roof. This tower is part of the medieval residence of the Gjon Markagjoni family. It's still a private residence, but can be viewed from outside.

Lead Mosque





The Lead Mosque (named after the material used on the roof) was built in 1773 at the cebnter of the Old Bazzar . The mosque is just a short walsk down from Rozafa Castle and is an evidence of the high economic standard of this part of the city at this time

Hamami (Public Baths)

Public baths is an important place among the social buildings of the medieval times. It was built in 1793 quite close to the city centre. It is a building without windows. The main part has its cupola, which consists of four divisions: one for undressing, one for sweating, with the other two for washing. Address: Rruga. Banja e Vogel.

Gjuhadol and Sarreq

Shkodra's most attractive quarters can be found in the area between the Colosseo hotel and the Cathedral. Both streets are lined with elegant turn of the 20th century buildings. *Sarreq* is the area around the cathedral, with a few fine old houses remaining

The Historical Museum

This museum is situated in a traditional house once owned by the Popular Hero Oso Kuka. It was built in the last quarter of the XIXthe century and bears great architectural and historic value. The museum's collection consist of 2700 authentic relics and artefacts, 5000 documents most of which are originals and 40000 documents on educational development. This church is a cultural monument located 20 km from the city of Shkodra, on the left bank of the Buna River. The church dates back from the 13th century (about 1290). It is built in Romanic-Gothic style. The ruins found today include some fragments of walls and the tombs of some monks. Address: near Obot Village, Shkoder

Mesi Bridge

Mes Bridge is built in the late 18C. The stone bridge is 108m long, one of the longest Ottoman bridges in the region. It stands on 13 arches with different sizes. Its subsidiary arches are an example of art and function meeting in perfect harmony. Address: Mes Village Shkoder





Drisht Castle lies in the remote hills above the Kir valley about 6km east of Mes. Although in a poor and neglected area now, Drisht was an important centre of civilisation in late antiquity and Byzantine times. The Drisht castle was constructed in the 13th century as a Byzantine fortress.

Characteristic Houses

Shkodra is well known for its houses with their open foyers (cardak). Houses of this kind belong to the middle of the XIX-th century. Some of them had the open foyer at the front of the house, others at the side. Most of them were two-stories houses, but the ground floor was inhabitable. Many of them inherit marvellous beauty of the ceilings, rosettes, chimneys, lofts, shelves and the yard gates.
